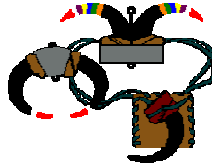


Tribe of Mannaseh



Recommendation for Shaman

From time to time, the Tribal Council may bestow upon youth Warriors additional responsibilities and opportunities for service to the Tribe. These roles are collectively referred to as “paint stations” because each new responsibility is publicly identified by a unique color of paint on the tips of the Warrior’s claws. The specific requirements for each paint station are described in the “Tribal Handbook”. But, as with other tribal recognitions, this paint stations is not something that can be sought or earned; each elevation begins with the tribesman being nominated by his unit leader or another qualified tribesman.

This form applies to youths who attained the rank of Warriors prior to the age of 18. They must continue to be active in their Scouting unit, continue to live up by the Scout Oath and Law and exemplify the ideals of Mannaseh.
