

Leader Specific Training for Scoutmasters & Assistant Scoutmasters

This course is designed for Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters, but is also useful to any other troop adult leader who plays a supportive role in the success of their unit. It will provide an introduction to what the Scoutmaster & Assistant Scoutmaster must “know, be, and do” to be a successful leader.

Three sessions, spread across two evenings, will show you: the Scoutmaster’s role in a boy led troop (troop organization, troop meetings, working with boy leaders, the patrol method, and the Patrol Leaders Council); the outdoors and the advancement program; and troop planning and administration (program planning, membership, paperwork, finances, the uniform, and other training opportunities).

Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters must also complete “Youth Protection Training”, “This is Scouting”, “Fast Start: Boy Scouting” and “Weather Hazards” (all available online), then also complete the Introduction to Outdoor Leadership Skills course, to be considered a “Trained” leader.

Cost: \$5 if received by 9/15, \$3 late fee added if not.
Training: starts promptly at 6:30pm on both evenings.
